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BACKGROUND DOCUMENTS

Minutes of the BLASJC meeting 29th January 2007

1.0 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The adjudication service is operated on a self-financing basis with income obtained from charges made to BLASJC member authorities.
- 1.2 At the meeting of Executive Sub-Committee held on 29th January 2007 it was agreed to: [i] adopt the Revenue Budget estimates for 2007/2008; [ii] adopt a zero capital budget for year 2007/8.
- 1.3 At the meetings on 30th June 2006, the National Parking Adjudication Service Joint Committee and Bus Lane Adjudication Service Joint Committee agreed that the adjudication service should, as far as possible, be provided in an integrated manner for both parking and bus lane appeals. This arrangement has represented an opportunity for cost sharing and the provision of an efficient and cost effective service.
- 1.4 For 2007/08, the administration of the two joint committees' accounts has been kept to a minimum by allocating actual expenditure based on the number of appeals received from each type of enforcement.
- 1.5 Case related expenditure for Bus Lane Appeals has been based on a prorata cost per Bus Lane appeal. This cost has been calculated from the NPASJC outturn for 2007/08.
- 1.6 This report provides details of the 2007/2008 final accounts for approval by the Joint Committee.

2.0 REVENUE ACCOUNTS

- 2.1 The accounts for 2006/2007 have been recorded and prepared by the Lead Authority.
- 2.2 During 2007/2008 the service received income of £65,300 and incurred expenditure of £43,930 producing a revenue contribution to reserves of £21,370 for the year.
- 2.3 Income for the year, was £31,411 higher than budget. Income is based on the number of penalty charge notices (PCN) that are issued by each participating council.

BUS LANE ADJUDICATION SERVICE JOINT COMMITTEE

Explanatory Foreword

This income and expenditure statement is the statutory summary of the Bus Lane Adjudication Service Joint Committee's (BLASJC) financial affairs for the year 2007/08, in accordance with the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2003. It demonstrates the Joint Committee's financial position for the year 2007/08 and presents its overall financial position at the end of that period.

In June 2006, the National Parking Adjudication Service Joint Committee and Bus Lane Adjudication Service Joint Committee agreed that the adjudication service should, as far as possible, be provided in an integrated manner for both parking and bus lane appeals. This arrangement has represented an opportunity for cost sharing and the provision of an efficient and cost effective service.

For 2007/08, following discussions with the Audit Commission, the administration of the two joint committees' accounts has been kept to a minimum by allocating expenditure based on the number of appeals received from each type of enforcement.

Case related expenditure for Bus Lane Appeals has been based on a pro-rata cost per Bus Lane appeal. This cost has been calculated from the NPASJC outturn for 2007/08.

During 2007/2008 the service received income of £65,300 and incurred expenditure of £43,930 producing a revenue contribution to reserves of £21,370. The combined surpluses as at 31st March 2008 amount to £21,393.

A full set of accounts has not been produced in respect of the Bus Lane Adjudication Service as this remains a relatively small service at this stage.
