BLAS/ 09/01 Minutes

Decision

BLAS/09/03 General Progress and Service Standards

A report of the Lead Officer was submitted on progress in relation to (a) the take up of civil enforcement of bus lane powers by Councils in England (outside London), and (b) service standard performance.

Additional information relating to the disposal of cases was circulated. The Head of Service outlined the main points of the report and responded to questions from members. She also informed the Joint Committee that a clearer picture of progress would be submitted to the meeting in June 2009.

The Chief Adjudicator then gave a presentation about the work of the Adjudicators and by showing a short presentation demonstrated to the Joint Committee some of the types of cases that had been before them. Reference was made to 'hot spots' in areas subject to civil enforcement with the common theme of appeals being that the driver was not aware of the bus lane restriction. Members agreed that signage was of great importance and that it was up to Councils to ensure all appropriate measures are undertaken to make drivers aware of bus lane restrictions. The Chief Adjudicator responded to comments and questions from Members.

Decision

- 1. To note the information in respect of the current and future take up of civil bus lane enforcement powers.
- 2. To note the performance attained against the agreed service standard indicators.
- 3. To note that a detailed report of performance in relation to hearings and case disposal for cases registered in 2008 will be presented to the meeting in June.

- 3. To note that the decision to provide a transcription from the audio recording of proceedings rests with the Adjudicator. Where this has been agreed to, the Joint Committee agree that the incidental cost of making a transcription from the audio recording of proceedings at a personal hearing is charged to the requesting party except when, in the view of the Adjudicator, a disability of the requesting party would make it desirable for that person to receive such a transcript.
- 4. To note that the Service Charge will be reviewed at the June meeting of the Joint Committee.
