NPAS/07/05 Final Accounts, 2006/2007

The final accounts for the years 2006/2007 were submitted. The accounts for 2006/07 are presented differently than in previous years because of changes to the Statement of Reporting Practice introduced for 2006/07. There has also been a requirement to restate accounts for 2005/06 in this way. The new presentation requirements have raised an issue around the presentation of accounts in previous years. The City Treasurer has signed the accounts on the basis that this will be addressed prior to the final audit letter.

NPAS/07/11 Traffic Management Act

The Chief Adjudicator informed the Joint Committee of the introduction of the Traffic Management Act (2004) on 31 March 2007. Representations had been made to the Department for Transport on behalf of the Joint Committee in response to their consultation on the draft regulations. Following the consultation, it was clear that the matters raised had not been taken into account. The Chair and Vice Chair wrote to the then Minister expressing their concerns particularly around the need to consider the impact of regulations on councils outside London. The response from the Minister was unhelpful.

A meeting is to be sought with the Minister to establish a way forward.
